### Granger Waste Services Contract Renewed

The Village of Pewamo has contracted waste removal services with Granger since 2012. Our contract expired and a new five year contract has been approved.

Prices effective May 1, 2022 will be locked in for a five year period. Granger will be mailing information to you regarding new trash carts along with a collection guide.

**The cost for services under the new contract will be \$16.59 per month.**

There is no discount for senior citizens. However, those over 65 are eligible to receive bag tag service. This service is a pay-as-you-throw trash collection without a cart. With this service, you purchase tags from the Village Office and place one tag on each bag you set out for collection. **The cost for a bag tags is \$2.00**

### Water/Sewer Rates

Water and Sewer rates will be increasing 3% effective 4/1/2021.

This increase will be reflected on your May billing.

Despite the "flushable" labels, these products should never be flushed because they will clog your toilet and the sewer system. The products do not breakdown and disperse in the sewer system which causes a risk of clogging your plumbing or causing damage to sewer infrastructure.
