Please avoid blowing grass clippings into the Village streets.

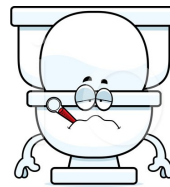
Grass clippings and yard waste clog storm drains and cause problems with drainage, which may result in flooding.

Protect Your Sewer System

DO NOT FLUSH "FLUSHABLE" WIPES

Despite the "flushable" labels, **these products should never be flushed because they will clog your toilet and the sewer system.** The products do not breakdown and disperse in the sewer system which causes a risk of clogging your plumbing or causing damage to sewer infrastructure.

Water/Sewer Rates

In 2022 Pewamo received a grant for an extensive study of our water system and the rates necessary to fund it.

The study recommended rate increases of 4.9% from 2022 through 2027. Based on this recommendation a 4.9% increase to Water Ready to Serve and Water Usage Rates will be implemented effective 4/1/26. Sewer rates will also see a 4.9% increase.

Please know that every effort is being made by your Council and DPW to ensure the safety and sustainability of our water and sewer systems

ARE THERE STAKES OR FLAGS MARKING UTILITIES IN YOUR YARD?

If so, Consumer's is likely intending to replace your gas line and meter. Please leave them in the yard until Consumers Energy completes their work in town.

We've been told that the resident can pull the stakes/flags for mowing purposes as long as they put them back in the same hole as it was placed.

Consumers intends to complete the gas line and meter replacements as fast as possible but does have till October to get the work completed.

Removing the stakes only delays the process and will require more MissDig tickets and markings. Removing stakes is a crime, which can result in a misdemeanor offense, as it can lead to damaged utilities.
